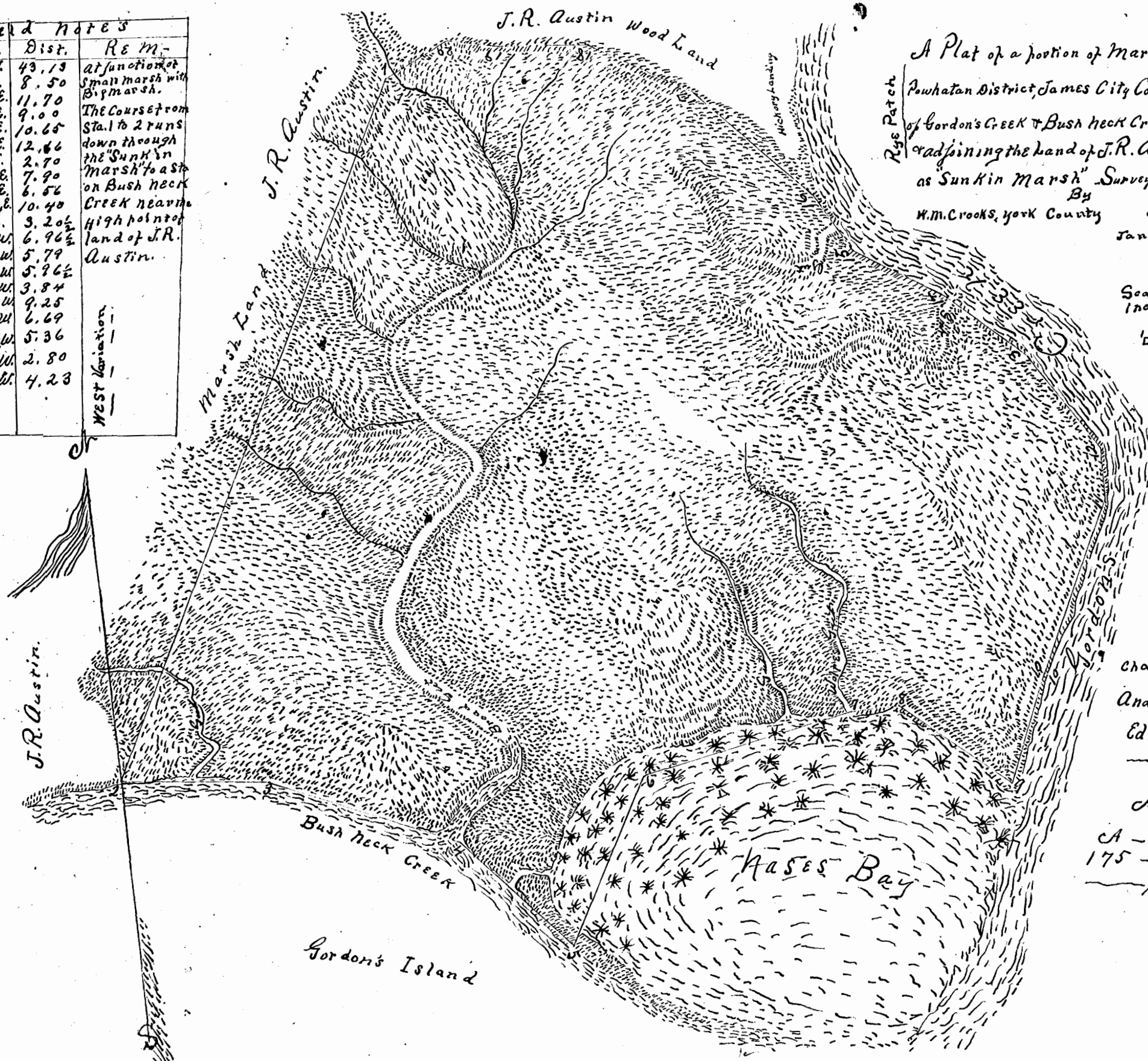

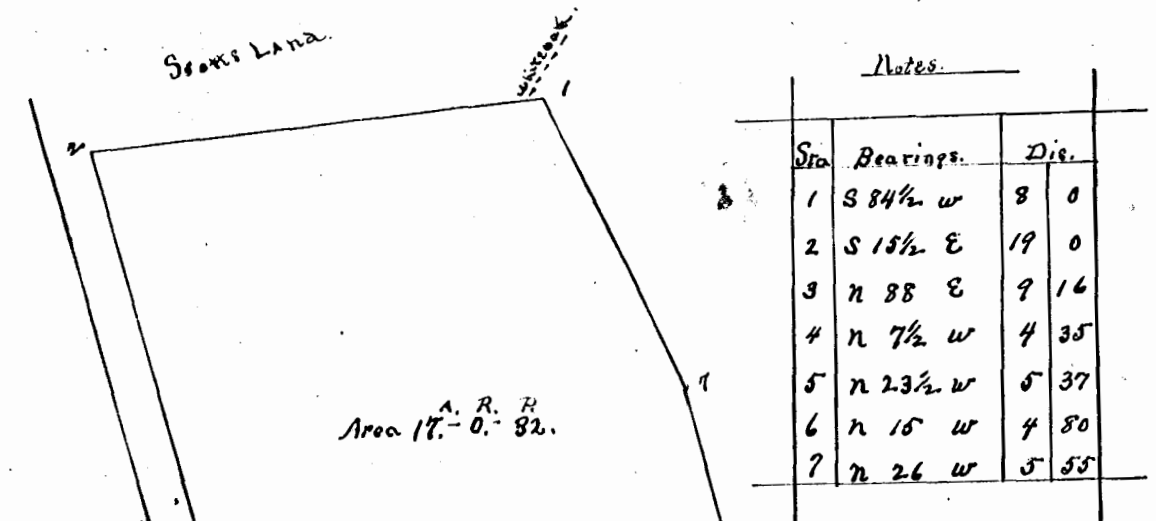


A Plat of a portion of Marsh Land, situated in

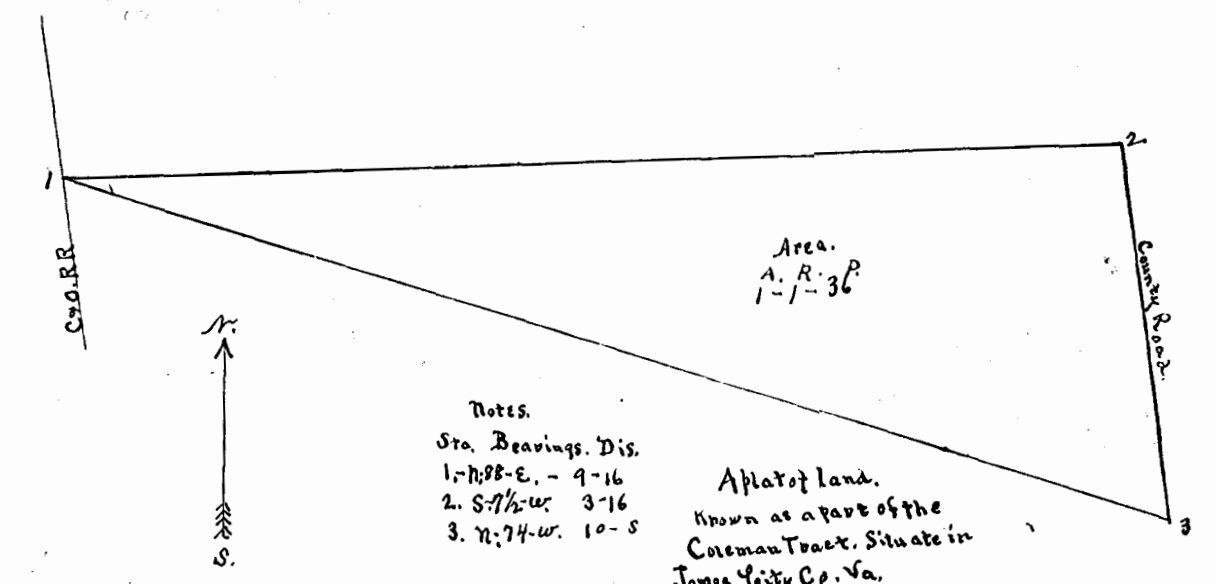
