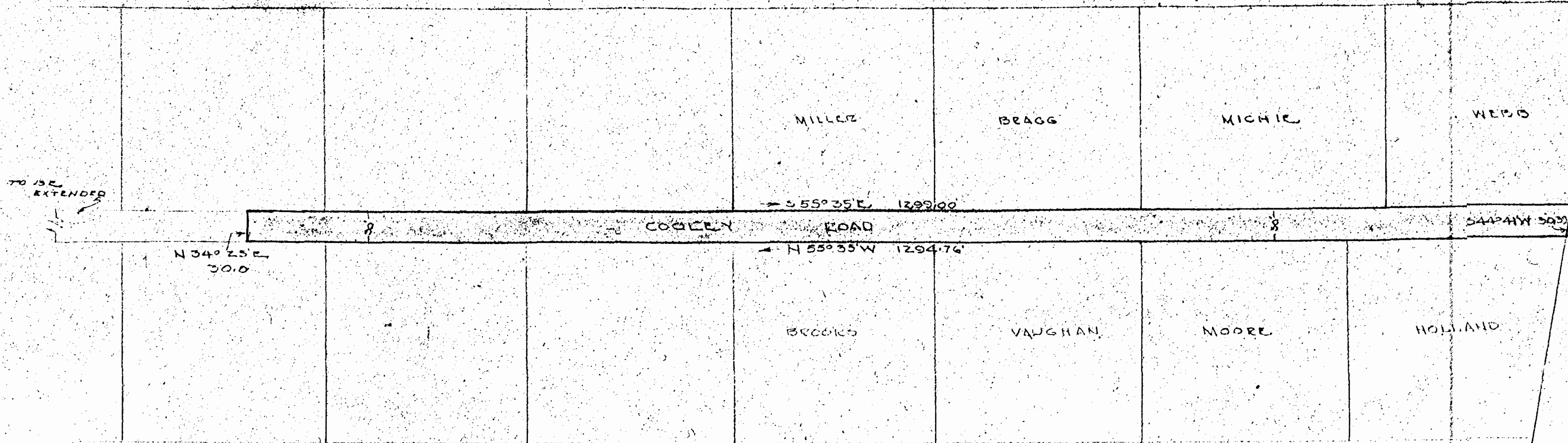

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS;

That we, EDWIN A. GILLEY and GLADYS C. GILLEY, husband and wife, do, by these presents and the recordation of the attached blueprint of plat, bearing the legend " Gladys C. Gilley, Plat Showing Section of Roadway to be Dedicated for Public Use, Jamestown District, James City County, Virginia", made by Vincent D. McManus, Surveyor, on April 10, 1952, dedicate to public use the 30-foot roadway known as Cooley Road, and shown on said plat, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on State Highway Route No. 5, at the northeast corner of the lot of Holland, and running thence N. 53° 35' W. 1294.76 feet to a point; thence N. 34° 25' E. 30 feet to a point; thence S. 55° 35' E. 1299.00 ft. to a point on said State Highway, being also the southwest corner of the Webb lot; thence S. 44° 41' W. 30.39 ft. to the point of beginning.
