DEED OF GIFT

THIS DEED OF GIFT, made this 3rd day of August, 1998, by and between EVANGELINE HAWKINS, unmarried, party of the first part, hereinafter called the Grantor, and EVANGELINE HAWKINS, 2808 Chickahominy Road, Toano, Virginia 23168, and GWENDOLYNN ROSS, 473 Park Avenue, 3rd Floor, Patterson, New Jersey 07504, parties of the second part, hereinafter called the Grantees.

WHEREAS, MARIAN TAYLOR (HAWKINS) died in 1986, leaving the herein described property to Evangeline Hawkins, and

WHEREAS, EVANGELINE HAWKINS is desirous of giving a joint interest to her daughter, Gwendolynn Ross;

WITNESSETH:

The Grantor does hereby give, grant and convey to the Grantees, as joint tenants with the right of survivorship, any and all of her right, title and interest in and to the following described real property, to-wit:

All that certain lot, piece or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in Powhatan District, James City County, Virginia, known and designated by the Lot 2A, containing 0.7733 acres, more or less, by survey, and being more particularly shown, set up and described on that certain plat entitled "Survey Of Property To Be Conveyed From The Zelus Taylor Estate To W. To include a right of way for ingress and egress in common with others as shown and designated as "50R/W" on the aforementioned plat. Subject to the restrictions and reservations regarding the road as set forth under "NOTE" on said plat.

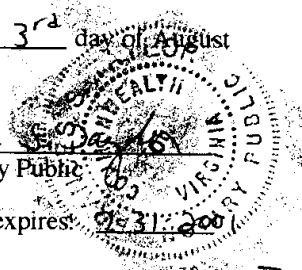

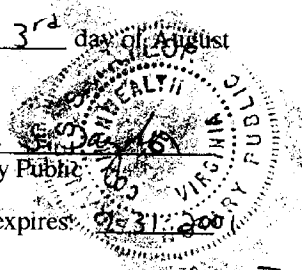
