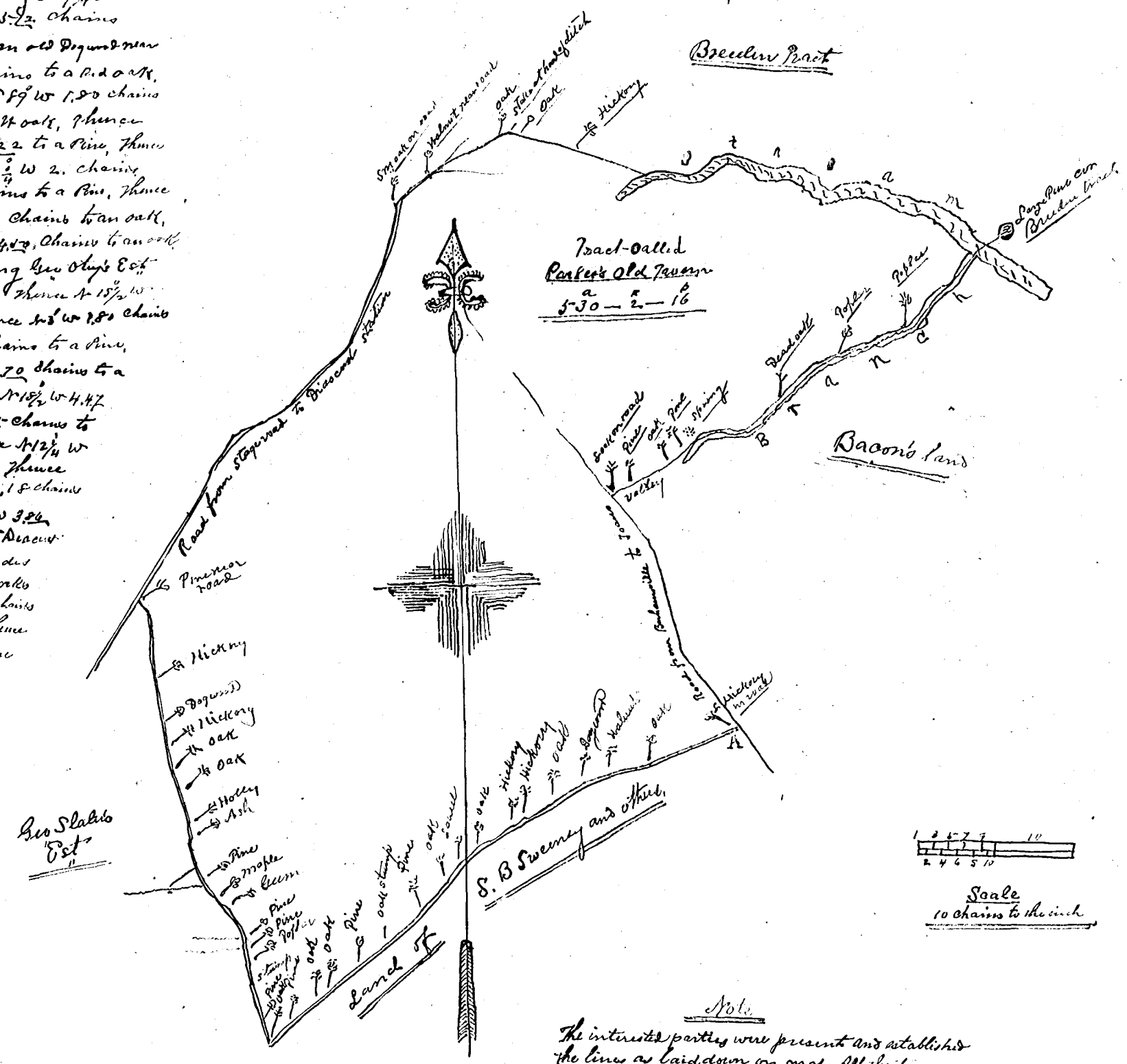


This figure represents a tract of land lying in James City County about four miles from Towns Station and on the old stage road and is a part of A.P. Richardson's Est. which I surveyed by request of Richardson and Wright and found to contain a small fraction over 500 acres, bounded as follows. Beginning at A a station near a Hickory tree near the road from Barhamsville to Towns and running S 87 1/2° W 12.22 Chains to a large Oak tree. Thence S 76 1/2° W 5.22 Chains to a Walnut tree. Thence S 7 1/2° W 2.72 Chains to an old fig tree near a newly marked Oak. Thence S 55° W 4.74 Chains to a P.O. Oak. Thence S 55 1/2° W 4.20 Chains to a Hickory. Thence S 55° W 1.80 Chains to a Hickory. Thence S 55 1/2° W 5.43 Chains to an oak. Thence S 47° W 3.12 Chains to a H. Oak. Thence S 30 1/2° W 2.22 to a Pine. Thence S 55 1/2° W 5.50 Chains to a Laurel. Thence S 40 1/2° W 2.00 Chains. Thence S 40° W 8.88 Chains. Thence S 40 1/2° W 2.72 Chains to a Pine. Thence S 40° W 4.20 Chains to a Pine. Thence S 49 1/2° W 5.22 Chains to an oak. Thence S 57° W 1.60 Chains to a Pine. Thence S 49 1/2° W 4.42 Chains to an oak. Thence S 40 1/2° W 3.22 Chains to an oak. Thence along the slope E 1/2° N 16° W 4.50 Chains and locating several marked trees. Thence N 15 1/2° W 1.52 Chains. Thence N 1/2° W 5.57 Chains to a stump. Thence N 15° W 2.80 Chains to a Pine and crossing stream. Thence N 61 1/2° W 1.80 Chains to a Pine. Thence N 59° W 4.57 Chains to a Gum. Thence N 59 1/2° W 1.20 Chains to a Gum. Thence N 38° W 3.16 Chains to a Pine. Thence N 15 1/2° W 4.42 Chains along stream. Thence leaving stream N 7° E 1.22 Chains to an Oak. Thence N 41° W 1.60 Chains to a Holly. Thence N 12 1/2° W 2.82 Chains to an oak. Thence N 17 1/2° W 4.76 Chains. Thence N 10 1/2° W 9.57 Chains to a Hickory. Thence N 8° W 2.18 Chains to an oak. Thence N 1/2° W 2.18 Chains. Thence N 1/2° W 3.22 Chains. Thence N 30 1/2° W 3.72 Chains to middle of road to Discour station. Thence along said road as it intersects in a Northwesterly corner 6.38 Chains to a Walnut near forks of roads (Public) Thence along said ditch N 77 1/2° E 2.18 Chains. Thence N 65 1/2° E 1.22 Chains. Thence N 67 1/2° E 1.88 Chains. Thence N 65 1/2° E 1.62 Chains. Thence N 66 1/2° E 1.62 Chains. Thence N 65 1/2° E 1.22 Chains. Thence N 67° E 1.42 Chains to a stake at head of ditch mowing. Thence S 17 1/2° E 1.14 Chains to a large Oak. Thence S 77° E 2.56 Chains. Thence S 7 1/2° E 2.52 Chains. Thence S 70° E 11.64 Chains to swamp. Thence along said swamp as it meanders in an Easterly course 42.94 Chains to a large Pine on side of swamp and crosses on the Bladen tract south swamp a branch of the big swamp which it enters into. Thence along said big swamp as it meanders in a Southwesterly course 48 Chains to head of said swamp and near a spring and valley. Thence along valley on N side S 62° W 12.5 Chains. Thence S 48 1/2° W 12.8 Chains. Thence S 62° W 3. Chains. Thence S 61° W 1.80 Chains. Thence S 65 1/2° W 1.22 Chains. Thence S 70° W 1.22 Chains. Thence S 64 1/2° W to middle of road and near a large (over) leading from Barhamsville to Towns. Thence along said road in a Southwesterly course 59.32 Chains to large Hickory. Thence by an old.

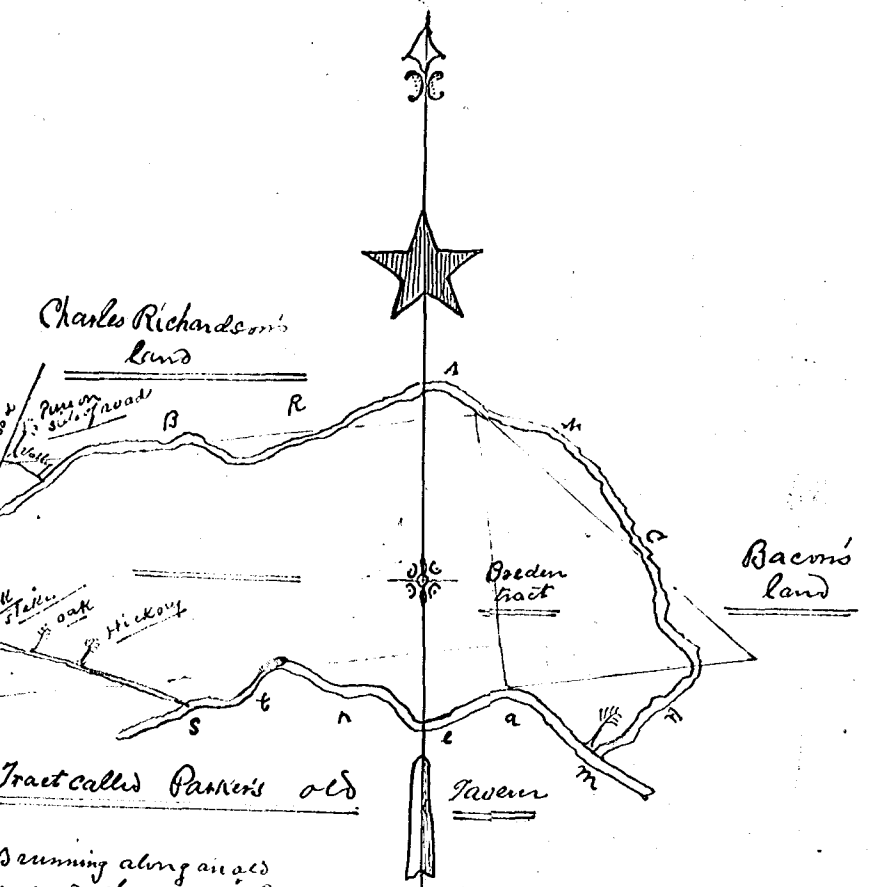


Note

Beginning at station A, a small Walnut tree on the stage road and running along an old ditch N 77 1/2° E 2.12 Chains. Thence N 63 1/2° E 1.22 Chains. Thence N 67 1/2° E 1.88 Chains. Thence N 65 1/2° E 1.62 Chains. Thence N 66 1/2° E 1.62 Chains. Thence N 67 1/2° E 1.42 Chains to a stake at head of ditch mowed. Thence S 77 1/2° E 11.64 Chains to a large oak tree. Thence S 77° E 2.56 Chains. Thence S 70° E 11.64 Chains to a stream. Thence along said stream as it meanders N 42 1/2° E 42.94 Chains to a large Pine near a branch. Thence up said branch as it meanders S 14° W 1.22 Chains. Thence N 37° W 8.88 Chains. Thence N 65 1/2° W 1.22 Chains to a River. Thence S 84 1/2° W 19.14 Chains to a tall oak stand near stage road. Thence crossing said road and running along an old fence meadow S 2 1/2° E 1.70 Chains to a Pine near road. Thence S 13 1/2° E 2.18 Chains to a Pine. Thence S 19° E 1.32 Chains to a Pine. Thence S 20 1/2° E 1.82 Chains. Thence S 14° E 7.78 Chains. Thence S 29° E 1.94 Chains. Thence S 36 1/2° E 2.42 Chains. Thence S 40° E 3.02 Chains to a large Pine. Thence S 48° E 2.22 Chains to an oak. Thence N 65° E 1.62 Chains began at.
