



A diagram showing the dividing line between the Tract of Land known as Crawleys' owned by E. S. Adkins & Co. and the tract of Land known as Greens & Ceasors owned by B. Larson, situated in James Town District, James City County, Virginia on the West side of the main Road leading from Williamsburg to Spotsylvania & Stafford Counties, as decided upon and located by the Arbitrators selected and appointed for the purpose by the owners of the said two several tracts of Land aforesaid, by their agreement in writing bearing date on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of May 1914. This line was surveyed & run by Sydney Smith, Esq. Surveyor for York County, at the request of and under the direction of T. H. Gaddy, Esq. & Mrs. Horace W. Dana, the Arbitrators aforesaid, on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of June 1914. This line starts at a stone in a pine stump on the West of the said Mill Road & runs around the same as indicated by the diagram. The Courses & distances are given on the diagram - Given under my hand this 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1914
