


TOANO TERRACE

Slater of Newport News Va. This piece of land is a part of a large tract of land owned by the said Slater. Surveyed and cut off from the original tract of the said Slater for the said Thomas P. Hammar, Nov. 23rd 1914 by Sydney Smith, Surveyor for York County divided into lots for the said Hammar by the same Surveyor on April 19th, 20th, 21st, 22nd, 23rd, 1915. This piece of land as a whole contains 10 ²⁸/₁₀₀ acres. The Courses and distances and division lines are given on the plat. 
