

AREA A: PRENTIS BURIALS

JUDGE PRENTIS'S MARBLE OF RECORD IN THE VIRGINIA STATE LIBRARY RECORDS THE FOLLOWING:
 JOSEPH PRENTIS AND MARGARET BOWDWIN MARRIED 16 DEC 1778
 WILLIAM B. PRENTIS BORN 1780 DIED 1783
 WILLIAM PRENTIS BORN 1783 DIED 1780
 JOHN B. PRENTIS BORN 1787 DIED 1784
 ROBERT W. PRENTIS BORN 1784 DIED 1784

MARGARET PRENTIS DIED AT GREEN HILL THE OLD MANSION 27 AUGUST 1801. JOSEPH PRENTIS DIED AT THE SAME PLACE 10TH JUNE 1804.

HIS WILL REQUESTED THAT HE BE BURIED NEXT TO HIS WIFE. AN UNDESIGNED DIED 1810 FOUND IN THE TULLOCH-GOSMAN PAPERS AT THE COLLEGE OF WILLIAM AND MARY RECITES THAT THERE WAS THEN A BRIDGE OF GROUNDS IN THE NORTH EAST CORNER OF THE EASTERNMOST SECTION ENCLOSED AND BELONGING TO THE USE OF THE FAMILY OF THE SAID JOSEPH PRENTIS ESQUIRE DECEASED FOREVER."

AREA B: ARMISTEAD - PENTON BURIALS

WILLIAM VELVERTON PENTON (THE CHILD OF COL. ARMISTEAD'S FIRST WIFE MARY) AND THE REV. WILLIAM S. PENTON DIED AT HIS UNCLE'S RESIDENCE IN WILLIAMSBURG ON THE 21ST DAY OF JULY 1851 AND WAS BURIED IN THE GRAVEYARD IN THE GARDEN ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE DECEASED CHILDREN OF HIS UNCLE.
 WILLIAM CLARK BORN 1846 DIED 1848
 SAMUEL BORN 1850 DIED 1854
 SAMUEL PENTON BORN 1855 DIED 1856

THE REV. WILLIAM S. PENTON DIED IN WILLIAMSBURG 12 SEPTEMBER 1851. COL. ARMISTEAD'S ACCOUNT BOOK CONTAINS AN ENTRY FOR THE BURIAL OF MARY TADE PENTON TO RICHARD M. BUCKTROT AN UNDERTAKER JULY 1, 1851. A REINTERRED SKELETON WAS FOUND NEAR THE GRAVE OF PENTON'S SON. MARY TADE IS BURIED NEXT TO HER BROTHER IN CEDAR GROVE CEMETERY.

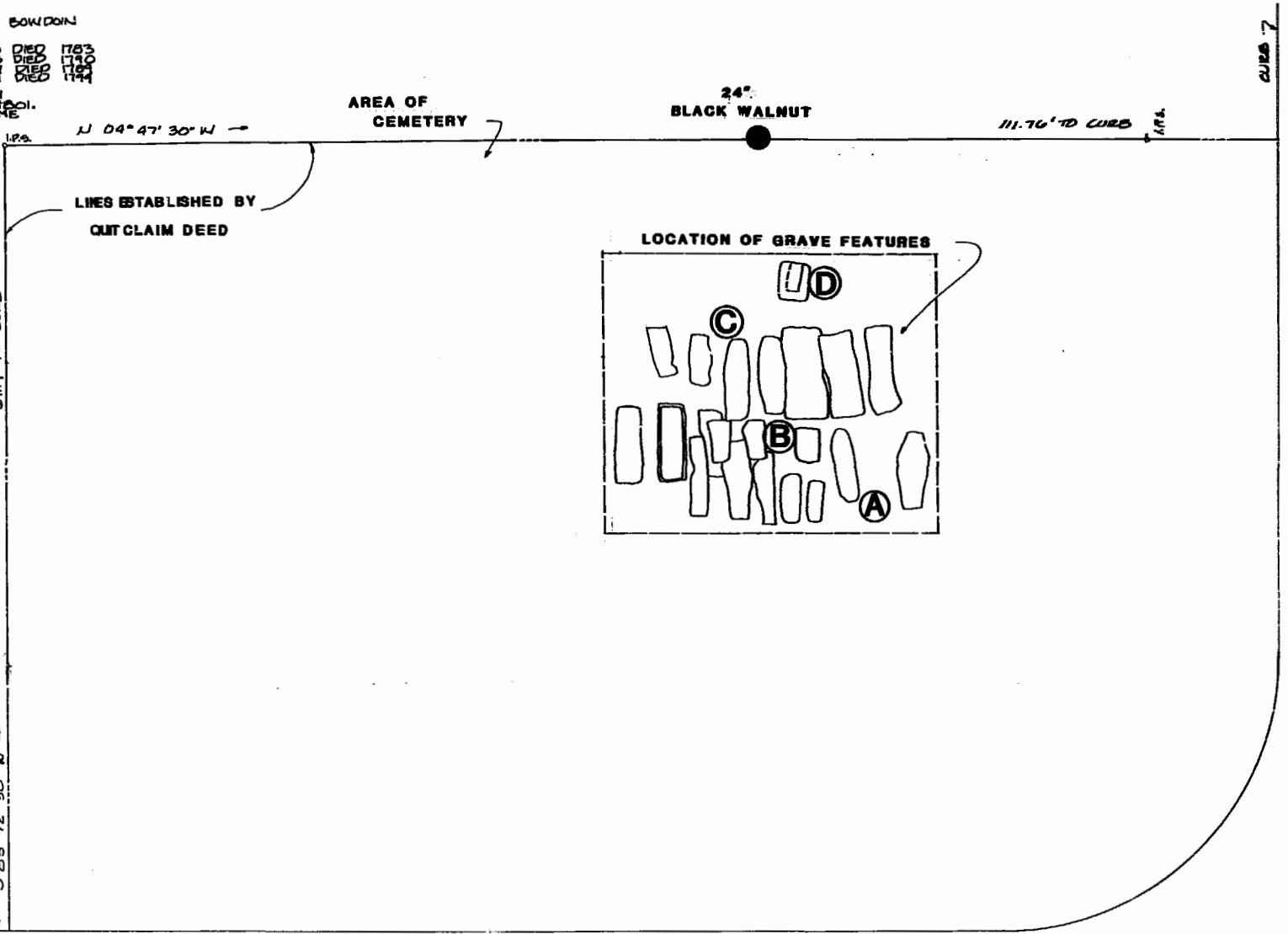
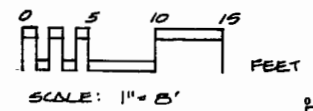
AREA C:

PROBABLY BURIALS WHICH OCCURRED WHEN GREEN HILL WAS OCCUPIED DURING THE CIVIL WAR.

AREA D:

INFANT DAUGHTER OF ROBERT TEANIS AND MARY TEANIS ARMISTEAD STILL BORN ON JANUARY 9, 1812.

REMAINING GRAVES ARE UNIDENTIFIED BUT APPEAR TO HAVE BEEN MADE AFTER 1810 WHEN GREEN HILL WAS OWNED BY JOHN ROBERT RANDOLPH AND JOHN B. GREGORY.

NOTE: THE GRAVE FEATURES SHOWN ON THIS PLAT WERE LOCATED BY REMOVING THE TOP SOIL AND SIEVING AND EXAMINING THE UNDERLYING MINELOAM SOIL FOR "STAINS" I.E. THE DIFFERENCE IN COLOR CAUSED BY EXCAVATION AND SUBSEQUENT REPAVEMENT OF SOIL. IT MAY NOT ESTABLISH THE EXACT LOCATION OF HUMAN REMAINS. TWO INFANT GRAVES IN LINE WITH EACH OTHER MAY APPEAR AS ONE ADULT GRAVE OR A GRAVE MAY HAVE BEEN DUG BUT NOT USED.
